

Departures within Greece
(from the mainland to the islands, from island to island, from the islands to the mainland)

We wish to inform you that according to the Government Gazette, regarding the “Extraordinary measures to protect the public health from the risk of further spread of COVID-19, all ferry trips (from mainland to the islands and other mainland ports, between the islands as well as from the islands to the mainland) are allowed if passengers:

- Have completed the COVID-19 vaccination, at least (14) days before the ferry trip and carry a vaccination certificate. Especially for those who have reached the age of sixty, and at least seven (7) months have passed since the completion of the vaccination, those who have received the booster dose are considered fully vaccinated. Or
- Have a negative molecular test (PCR) for COVID-19 by taking an oral or nasopharyngeal smear within the last seventy-two (72) hours before the scheduled departure time or a negative antigen (rapid test) for COVID-19 within forty-eight (48) hours before the scheduled departure time. The negative molecular PCR test and the negative antigen rapid test diagnoses are proven by the presentation of a relevant certificate, or
- Show a certificate of illness, issued thirty (14) days after the first positive test and lasting for ninety (90) days after it. Specifically, the certificates of illness issued from 08.07.2021 until 31.10.2021 remain valid in accordance with the applicable one hundred and eighty (180) days after the first positive test and however not beyond 31.01.2022. The validity of the certificates of illness issued from 01.11.2021 to 04.12.2021 lasts ninety (90) days. Or
- Show an EU vaccination certificate (digital COVID certificate) and/or a third countries' vaccination certificate.

From the above obligation are excluded:

- Minors up to three (3) years old
- Minors from four (4) to eleven (17) years old, may travel with a negative weekly self-diagnosis test (Self-test) within twenty-four (24) hours before the scheduled departure time

The use of a protective mask is mandatory.

Passengers are advised to arrive at the port of departure on time, for convenience of the control procedure before boarding.
